

## **Achievements under SSS in the year 2015-16**

Under SSS (ISSP) scheme of Govt. of India, CSO has earmarked an outlay of Rs. 43.76 crores for Uttar Pradesh. MoU related to SSS was signed by state and MOSPI on 03.11.2015. 1st instalment of the scheme of Rs. 6.00 crore was released by GOI to Govt. of U.P. on 23.11.2015 and the Govt. of U.P. released the amount to DES U.P. on 26.01.2016. The current progress of the activities undertaken by the scheme so far is as follows -

The period of survey is from Jan-16 to Dec-16. The survey period of this round will be divided into four sub-rounds of three months' duration each. For the survey 2432 samples are selected. The Schedules of enquiry to be canvassed during survey are- 1. Schedule 0.0- Listing schedule 2. Schedule 11-House hold consumer 3. Schedule 99- poverty module 4. Schedule 0.25- school information. Till 31.03.2016, 534 units have been surveyed in first subround.
