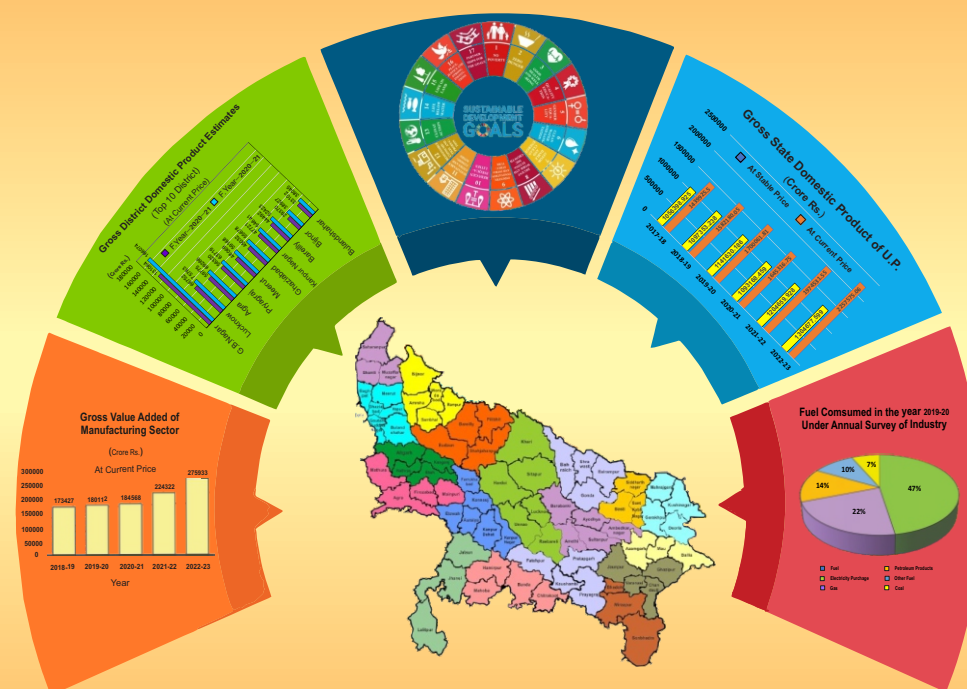

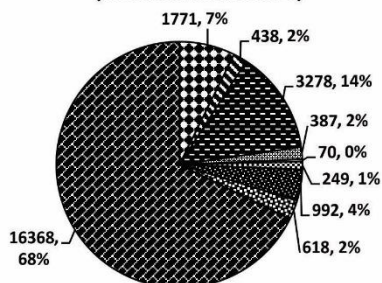
MAP OF UTTAR PRADESH



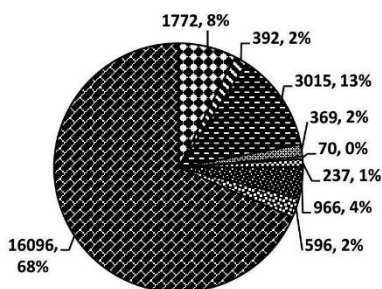
ESTIMATED MAP

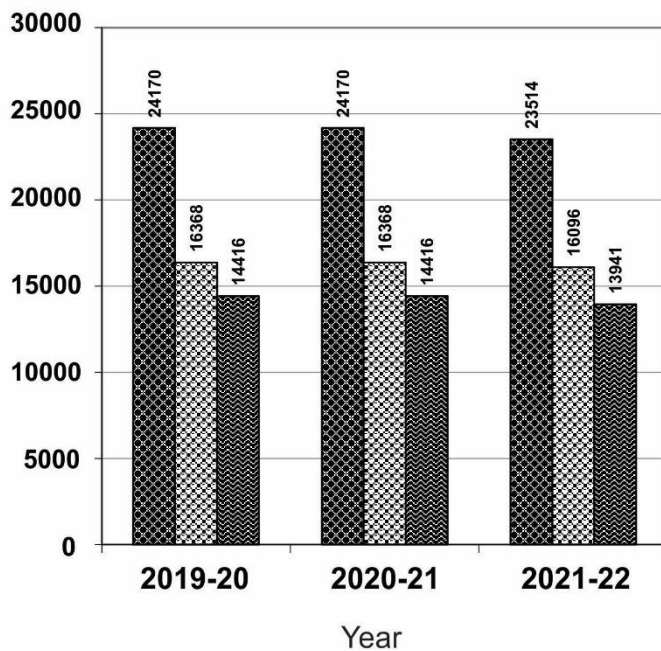

AREA UNDER AGRICULTURE IN U.P.

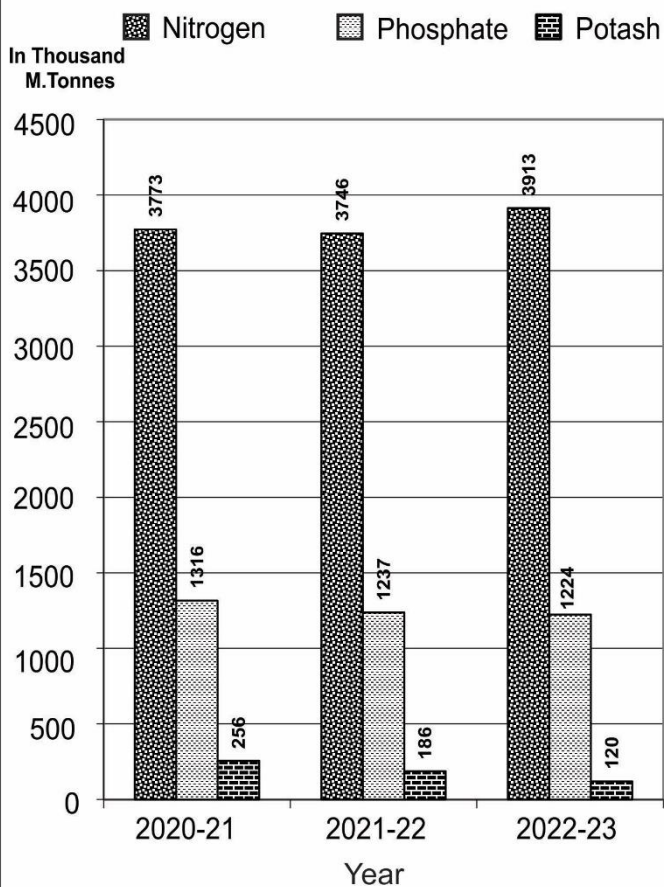

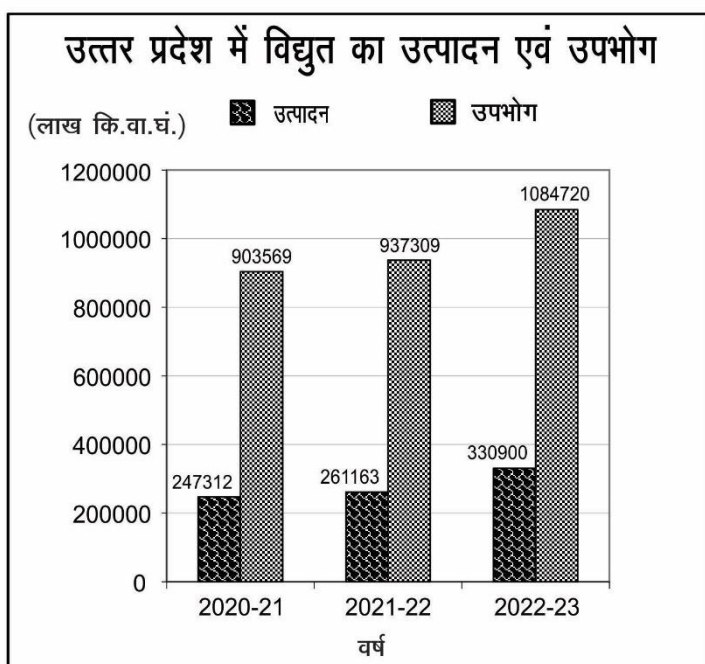
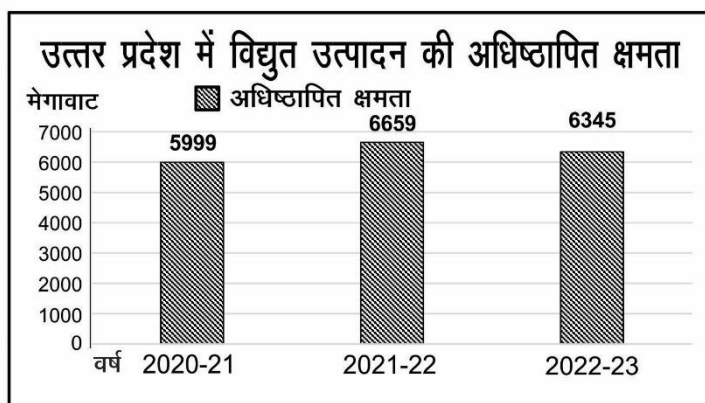
