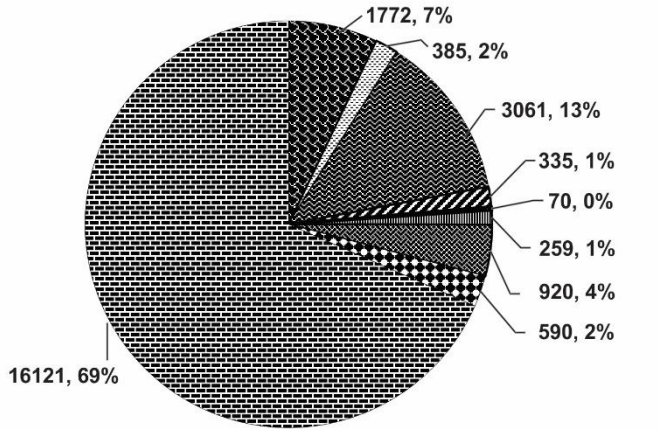

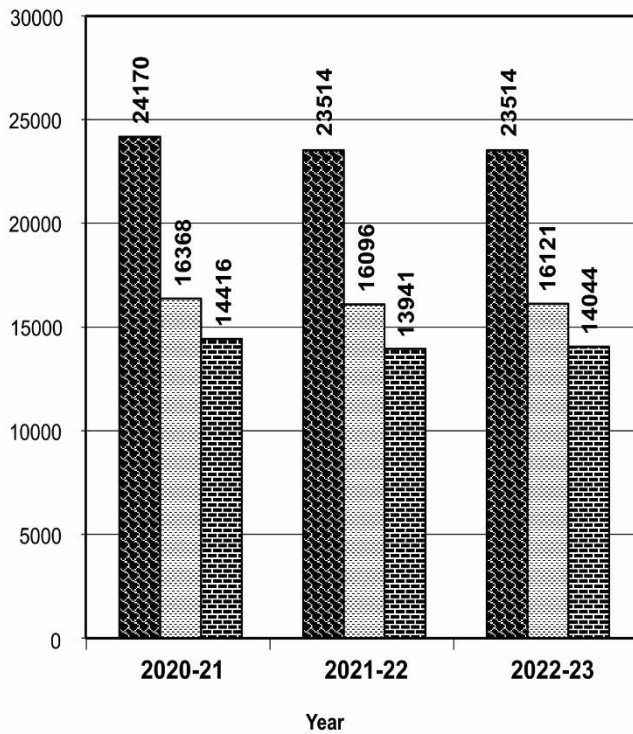

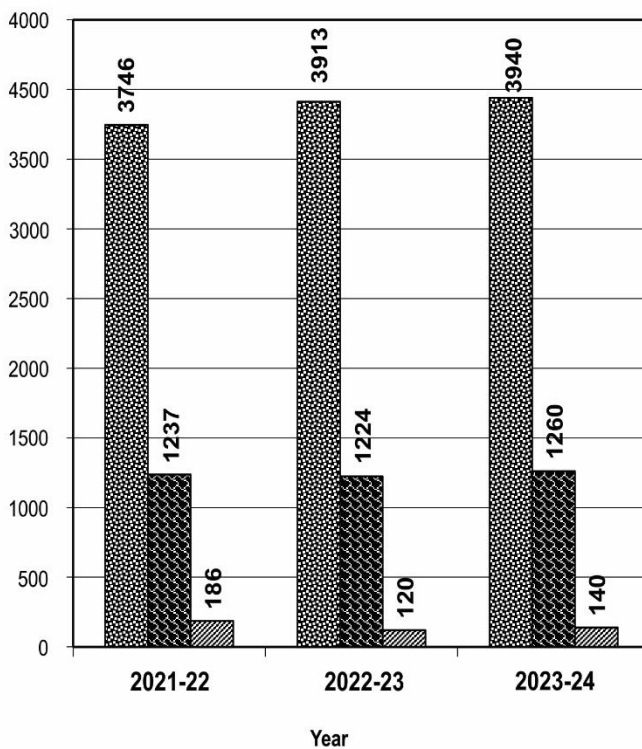

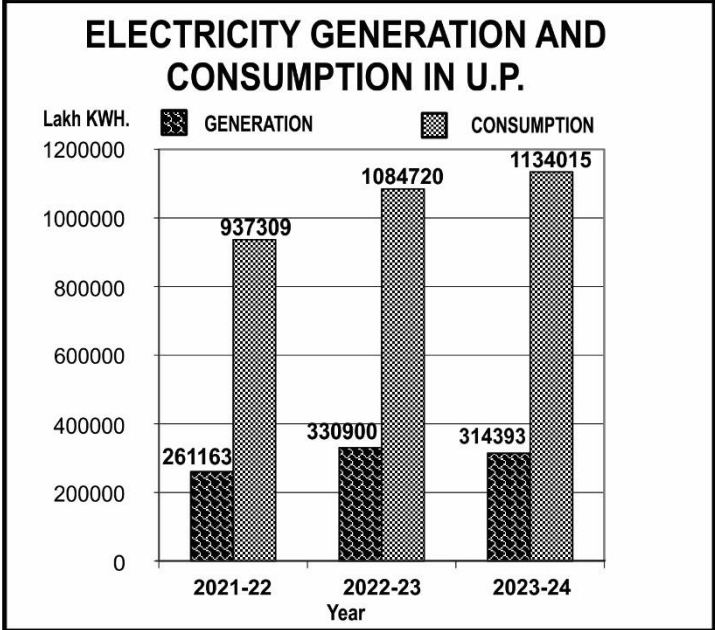
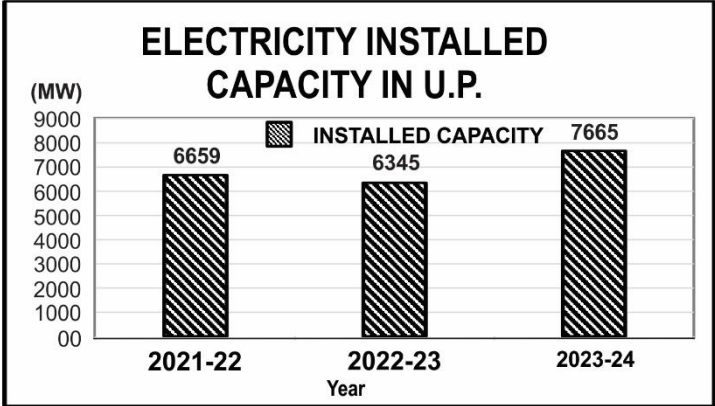


DISTRIBUTION OF CHEMICAL FERTILIZER IN U.P.
